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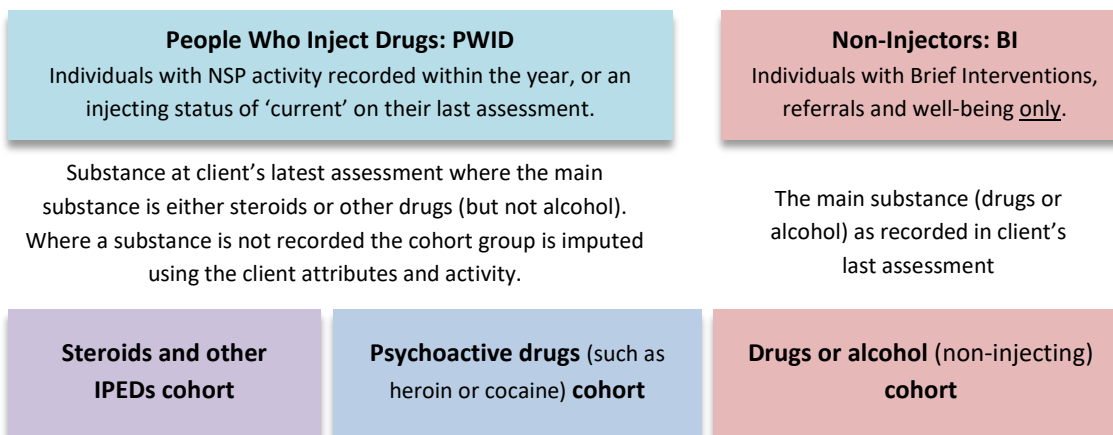
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INTRODUCTION

This report contains the data tables for the 2018-19 dataset for the Integrated Monitoring System (IMS) which collates data from 93 pharmacies and 38 agency sites across the Cheshire and Merseyside sub-region. As with previous years, the data is split into three distinct cohorts as described below. Where a primary substance is not stated, we have used imputation techniques to assign the individual to one of the three cohorts.



There was a 22.8% decrease in the number of individuals reporting to the system between 2017-18 and 2018-19, which includes a 28.2% decrease in the psychoactive drug injecting cohort, a 31.2% decrease in the steroids and other Image and Performance Enhancing Drugs (IPED) injecting cohort, and a 3.8% decrease in the Brief Interventions only (non-injectors) cohort. While most areas have seen differing degrees of decreases, some such as Wirral have seen overall increases in their numbers reporting to IMS. The full report will explore some of the reasons for this variation and the decreases where they have occurred.

Heroin remains the main substance injected for the psychoactive injecting cohort (79.7%). Of these individuals injecting heroin, crack cocaine is the most commonly cited secondary substance (86.1%). Where a housing status is completed, almost half (46.8%) of individuals in the psychoactive injecting cohort report some kind of housing issue, compared to 5.6% from the steroids and other IPEDs injecting cohort.

The data tables precede a full report which will include cross-matched data from Public Health England (PHE) for individuals reporting to the National Drug Treatment Monitoring System (NDTMS). This will be published early in 2020.


